<b>Student visa (DH)</b>	<p>Exchange and study abroad students need to have the student visa (<b>visa DH</b>) sponsored and applied by Hanoi University.</p> <p>The visa procedure takes from <b>1 to 1.5 months</b> as the following steps:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>HANU issues a Letter of Acceptance, at which course major and duration are claimed;</li> <li>HANU applies visa DH for the exchange student: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Visa type: <b>Single</b> ;</li> <li>- Visa duration: within the exchange period;</li> </ul> </li> <li>HANU emails the exchange student visa details;</li> <li>The exchange student gets visa DH at the Vietnamese Embassy/Consulate in the country as registered in the Student Exchange Application Form.</li> </ol>

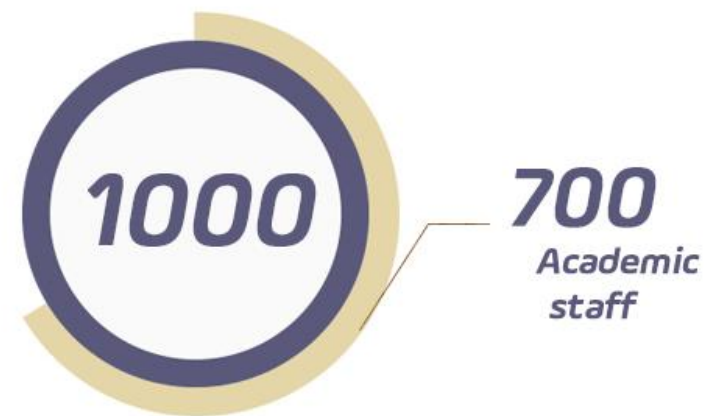

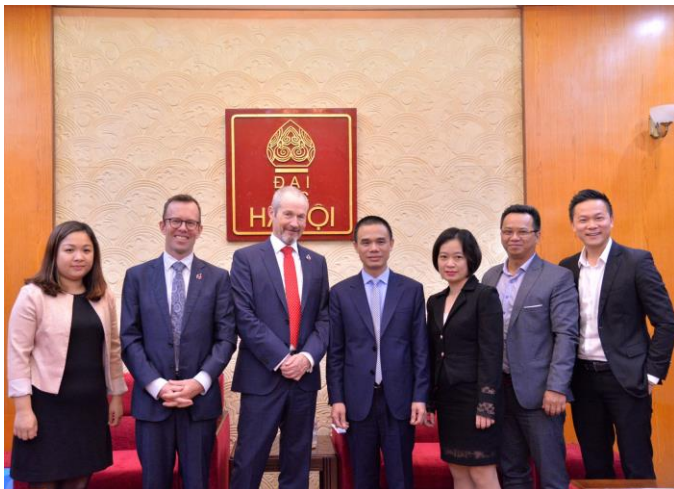
